

The Creative Generation: Design students invite you to create a hexagon letter fold.


Hexagons are symbols of connection, coherence and stability. Follow the below steps to fold a drawing of a symbolic object into a hexagon.

Once you have finished your fold, you may want to add text about the person or place referred to in your drawing. You can watch a person fold their hexagon letter in this video: qago.ma/hexagon







Fold an A4 page in half




Fold both outside edges into the centre



Fold a triangle in from the left corner the meet the centre line



Open the right side and fold a triangle back over from the left




Fold the right side back over

to meet the centre line




Fold half a hexagon upward



Return the half hexagon back to reveal a guideline




Fold the top half of the page down diagonally along the axis

Fold the remaining part in half to create the 5th triangle



Fold the same strip inwards to form the 6th side



Locate and open the first pocket created at step 3



Tuck the final strip into the pocket and smooth all folds
